TYPE OF WINE:	White
D.O.:	Rías Baixas
GRAPE VARIETIES:	Albariño, Treixadura, Caiño, Loureira y Godello.
AGEING:	None

---

**WINEYARD:** Vineyard divided into plots located in the O Rosal subzone. South orientation and next to the Miño River and the Atlantic Ocean creating a microclimate ensuring an optimum ripening of the grape.

---

**WINEMAKING:** Manual harvesting and fermentation separately from the different varieties

---

**SOIL:** Granitic, sandy and very permeable. Very well-drained soils, without standing water, producing a very fine wine, with balanced acidity and aromas from the variety.

---

**CLIMATE:** Atlantic, mild temperatures during the summer allowing a slow and gentle ripening and the conservation of fruity aromas.

---

**COLOUR:** Straw yellow with greenish reflections.

**AROMA:** Intense, with notes of pineapple, pulp fruits white and yellow flowers.

**TASTE:** Fresh, with a prolonged fruity finish.

**GASTRONOMY:** Selfish, sushi, pasta and white meat.
